pursuant to and for the purposes of art. 13 of the EU Regulation n. 2016/679 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data

Dear Customer/Supplier,

We wish to inform you that the European Regulation no. 679 of 27 April 2016 on the processing of personal data provides for the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data. Pursuant to Article 13 of the REG. EU 2016/679, we invite you, therefore, to take note of the following information.

1. Identification of the Controller

The Data Controller is Forgiatura Moderna Arese S.p.a. with registered office in Milan, Via Archimede 57, in the person of the legal representative Augusto Ambrogio Vienna email qa@fmaspa.it.

2. Purpose of the processing

The processing of personal data provided by you is aimed solely at:

- a) Execution and management of the contract and protection of rights relating thereto;
- b) Compliance with obligations established by laws related to the contractual relationship;
- c) Forward communications and exchange information aimed at the execution of the contractual relationship, including pre and post contractual activities.

The legal basis of the treatment is the contract.

3. Method of treatment

Personal data will be processed in paper, computerized and telematic form and introduced in the relevant databases that will be accessible to the person in charge of data processing.

The processing may also be carried out by third parties who provide specific processing, administrative or instrumental services necessary to achieve the aforementioned purposes.

All data processing operations are carried out in such a way as to guarantee the integrity, confidentiality and availability of personal data.

4. Data retention period

The data provided will be kept for the duration of the contractual relationship.

5. Scope of communication and sharing of data

In relation to the purposes indicated in point 2, the data may be disclosed to the following categories of recipients:

- third parties (for example: companies, professionals, credit institutes, employees);
- authority (for example: judicial, administrative, fiscal, social security).

6. Rights referred to in Articles 15, 16, 17 18, 20, 21 and 22 of REG. UE 2016/679

We inform you that as an interested party, you have the right to submit a complaint to the Supervisory Authority (art.77) and the rights listed below, which you can exercise by sending a specific request to the Data Controller as indicated in point 1.

Art. 15 - Right of access

The interested party has the right to obtain from the data controller confirmation that it is or is not undergoing treatment of personal data concerning him and in this case, to obtain access to personal data and information concerning the treatment.

Art. 16 - Right of rectification

The interested party has the right to obtain from the data controller the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning him without undue delay. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, the data subject has the right to obtain the integration of incomplete personal data, also by providing an additional declaration.

Art. 17 - Right to cancellation (right to be forgotten)

The interested party has the right to obtain from the data controller the deletion of personal data concerning him without undue delay and the data controller is obliged to cancel the personal data without undue delay.

Art. 18 - Right to limit the processing

The interested party has the right to obtain from the data controller the limitation of processing when one of the following hypotheses occurs:

- a. the interested party disputes the accuracy of personal data, for the period necessary for the data controller to verify the accuracy of such personal data;
- b. the processing is illegal and the interested party opposes the cancellation of personal data and asks instead that its use is limited;
- c. although the data controller no longer needs it for processing purposes, personal data are necessary for the interested party to ascertain, exercise or defend a right in court;
- d. the interested party objected to the treatment pursuant to Article 21 (1), pending verification of the possible prevalence of the legitimate reasons of the data controller with respect to those of the interested party.

Art. 20 - Right to data portability

The interested party has the right to receive, in a structured, commonly used and automatically readable form, the personal data concerning him / her provided to a data controller and has the right to transmit such data to another data controller without impediments from part of the data controller who supplied them.

In exercising its rights relating to the portability of data in accordance with paragraph 1, the interested party shall have the right to obtain direct transmission of personal data from one controller to another, if technically feasible.

Art. 21 - Opposition right

The interested party has the right to oppose at any time, for reasons connected with his particular situation, to the processing of his personal data pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, letters e) or f), including profiling on the basis of these provisions.

Art. 22 - Right not to be subjected to automated decision making, including profiling

The interested party has the right not to be subjected to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning him or which significantly affects his person.
